Judging based on the OAAS Ontario Fairs Agriculture and Horticultural Judging Standards for Ontario Fairs~ Revised 2020

1. Entry tags must be firmly attached on the items being exhibited.
2. Vegetables to be cleaned but not washed. A nylon stocking or soft cloth may be used for cleaning. Onions must be cleaned, but not peeled, except for jagged and dirty outer scales. Remove roots just below the bulb.
3. Except where noted, all vegetables are to be shown on a sturdy plastic or paper plate.
4. Please ensure that your entries match the description indicated beside each item i.e. quantity or size
5. In cases of multiples, the judge is looking for uniformity of colour, shape and size and free of blemishes.
6. In the event of only one entry in a section, the judge has the power to withhold a 1st place award and recommend it for only a 2nd or 3rd.

Sections 1 - 19:

1. **Cucumber, 3 regular slicing, 6" length and over with short stem**
2. **Cucumber, 3 English, 6" length and over with short stem**
3. **Sweet peppers 3, ½"- 1" stem, any colour, 4 points or crowns**
4. **Carrots, 5 long, over 4", no visible side roots, ½"- 1" green top, tap roots left on**
5. **Carrots, 5 short, 2"- 4", no visible side roots, ½"- 1" green top, tap roots left on**
6. **Beets, 5 table, 1/2"- 1" top, roots trimmed to 1", rubbed clean only**
7. **Squash, 1 Acorn pepper, short stem (should be completely green)**
8. **Squash, 1 Butternut, short stem**
9. **Tomatoes, 5 any colour with calyx**
10. **Tomato, 1 largest red or green with calyx**
11. **Tomatoes, 10 Cherry, red or yellow with calyx**

12. **Garlic, 3 bulbs, 1" top, roots trimmed to 1/2"**
13. **Onions, 3 yellow, 1"- 2" top, roots removed just below bulb**
14. **Onions, 3 red, 1-2" top, roots removed just below bulb**
15. **Onion, 1 largest, 1"- 2" top, roots removed just below bulb**
16. **Eggplant, 1**
17. **Beans, 5 green or yellow with short stem and tip attached**
18. **Regular Broad bean, 3 any colour with short stem and tip attached**
19. **Zucchini, 2 small, 5"- 7", short stem**
20. **Leeks, 3, 5"-6" top**
21. **Root vegetable, most abnormal shape**
22. **Cabbage, any colour**
23. **Potatoes, 5 white flesh**
24. **Potatoes, 5 yellow flesh**
