Rules:

Amateurs only. Please!

Place all heavy flowers in a weighted container.

All precautions will be taken to safeguard exhibitor's containers however, the Orangeville Agricultural Society cannot be responsible for any mishap. Please do not use expensive or heirloom containers.

Flowers must be grown by the exhibitors, except in the decorative arrangement class where additional materials may be purchased.

Decorative arrangements, unless otherwise stated, use fresh flowers only, adding foliage and accessories to carry out your version of these sections.

Biennials may be shown as perennials.

Rose blooms should be $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ open at judging time.

NO flower arranging in the hall on the day of the fair.

The committee reserves the right to remove any wilted, or dead flowers.

Please ensure the entry tags are securely attached to the exhibit.

The condition of plant material, and artistic effect, of the design will be judged. Note – the container is part of the design.

The Judge's decision is final for awarding of the prizes.

The Judging & Exhibiting Standards for Horticultural & Floral Design 2019 will apply in all sections of Class 28. This booklet is available from the local horticultural society.

Another source for judging criteria is the **Agriculture & Horticulture Judging Standards for Ontario Fairs – revised 2020**.

Elements & Principals of Design used in the judging are explained in detail in the above-mentioned booklets.

Use of space, line, form, colour, texture, balance, rhythm, proportion, scale, contrast & dominance.

Hints:

The Quality and variety of blooms and the artistic effect of the exhibit will be judged.

Also, consider chief points of design, harmony, distinction, & originality, suitability to the occasion, harmony and relation to the container. These are all considerations when judging.

Prizes: 1st: \$5; 2nd: \$4; 3rd: \$3.

Annuals

1. Cosmos - 3 Blooms.
2. Dahlias - 3 blooms the same variety.
3. Dahlias - 3 blooms different varieties.
4. Marigolds - 3 blooms.
5. Sunflowers - bouquet of 3-5 stems, with appropriate foliage.
6. Petunias - 3 sprays.
7. Zinnias - 3 blooms.

8. Any **named** annual not included in Sections 1-9, 3 blooms.

Perennials

9. Ornamental grass (cultivated) 3 fresh stems of 1 variety, displayed in a vase.
10. Sedum - 3 stems displayed in a vase.
11. Hosta leaves - collection of 3 different kinds, 1 stem each.
12. Hydrangea – any type of hydrangea - 3 stems with foliage.
13. Rose, 1 stem, 1 bloom (3)
14. Rose, miniature variety, 1 stem, 1 bloom
15. The Reid Trophy Special: The judge will select the “best overall rose” from Sections 13 and 14. In memory of Edith Perfect Reid (July 15, 1874 – May 12, 1974) Prize: \$20 donated by the Reid Family.
16. Any named perennial not included in Sections 9 -15 (above), 3 blooms.

House Plants

17. Cactus, any kind. One specimen.

DECORATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

18. DUFFERIN FORAGED INKS SPECIAL: -
An arrangement in a recycled container – “Once Again”.
Prizes: 1st: \$15; 2nd: \$10; 3rd: \$5.

19. **GROUND GUYS SPECIAL:**



“Pinecones and Pinwheels”. An arrangement using Pinecones and Pinwheels to illustrate the Orangeville Fair Theme 2025. Prize: 1st: \$15; 2nd: \$10; 3rd: \$5.

20. DORI EBEL SPECIAL - “SUMMER FUN” for Participants 7 Years of Age & Under: – A colourful arrangement in a mason jar incorporating a pinwheel. Prize: 1st: \$15; 2nd: \$10; 3rd: \$5
